Overview of Filament Support for the LulzBot Platform

We pride ourselves on our high standard of quality and user experience. All 38 types of filament offered through our web store have custom-developed print settings in Cura LulzBot Edition. These are determined by our R&D department using rigorous testing standards.

Our filament evaluation process is broken into three separate phases:

Phase 1

- Review SDS sheet for safety and health concerns.
- Conduct a basic feasibility study to determine if there is a market demand for this specific filament.
- Generate an initial testing report.

Phase 2

- Conduct a more thorough feasibility study to determine specific quantities.
- Our R&D department begins profile generation for our machines/software.
- Review printed samples.

Phase 3

- Fine tune R&D profiles for optimal results.
- Determine marketing strategy.
- Place initial order.

During any one of the phase reviews above, it is possible for the filament to be rejected. All of our filament evaluation forms and results will be posted online. (Supplier information forms and Product information forms will not be posted publicly.)
